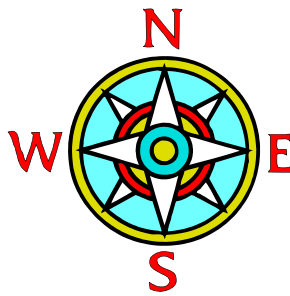
Some Facts about Pinellas County

Directions on Maps

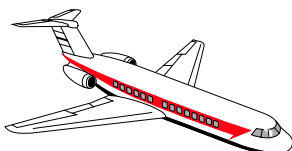
- N = North (top)

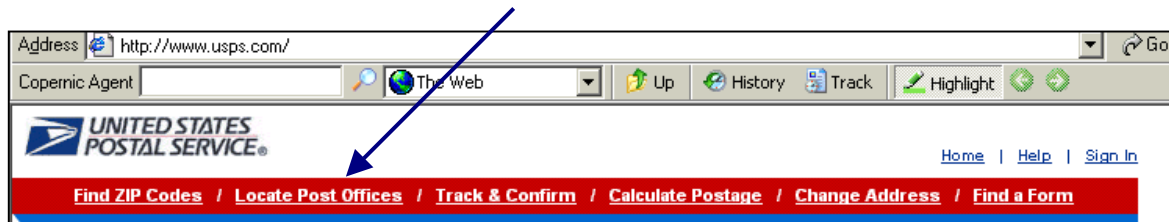





There are many county parks in Pinellas County. The county government runs county parks. There are also many city parks in Pinellas County. (City parks are run by cities.)

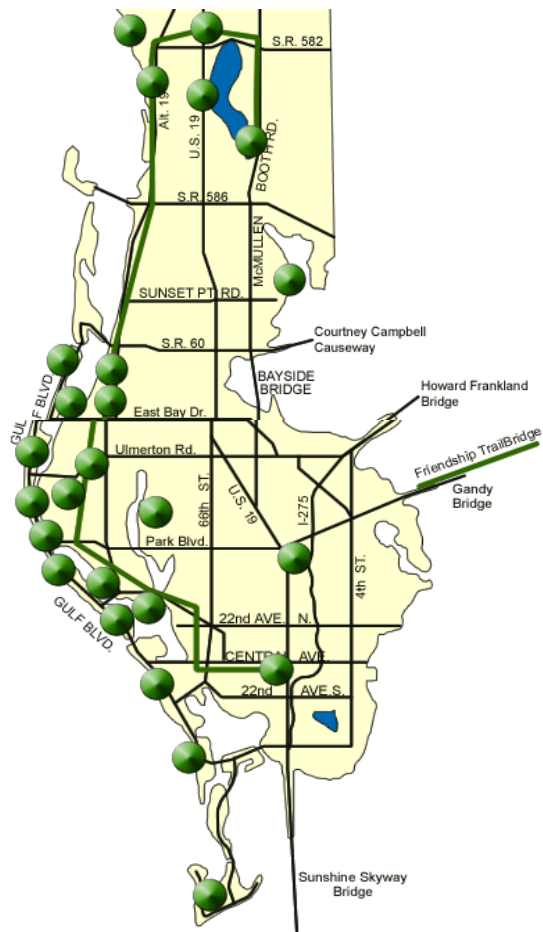


Several Pinellas County parks are on the Gulf of Mexico
